I am vehemently opposed to the Donlin Gold mine operation near the Kuskokwim River. This pristine area is the heart of my people, providing sustenance for thousands of years. Our traditional way of life calls upon our people to tread lightly and take only what we need. All flora and fauna are considered sacred, in that they sustain us.

I do not believe technology exists that can assure complete safety of either the environment or the inhabitants as Donlin Gold has promised.

While it is true that Donlin Gold might provide a few jobs for Native Alaskans now, it is also true that when all the gold has been stripped from earth, Donlin Gold will leave behind, leaving only a large, poisoned wound in our land, that no longer provides for our needs.

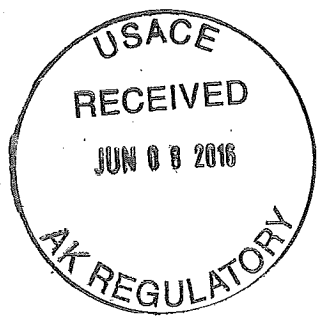
