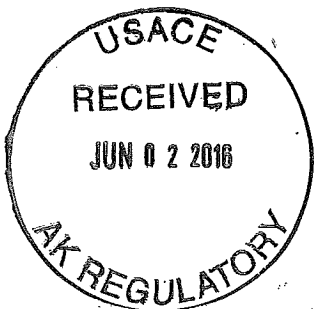


The public comment period on the Donlin Gold project has been extended.
