Overview:

The Donlin Gold Project EIS presentation was given on Tuesday, June 9, 2015, in Lower Kalskag, Alaska at the City Building by Senior Specialist for Rural Community Engagement, Donne Fleagle.

The presentation included a summary of the project components; an overview of the EIS process; a synthesis of the scoping comments; the process for developing alternatives; the TEK workshops, results of the fish studies conducted during summer 2014, and contact information for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

Issues Raised:

Question: One older gentleman was interested in the naturally occurring mercury at the mine site and what level it was at.
